



Series/Prefixes

The earliest and latest verified series/prefixes are shown in the following listings. Be advised that not all series/prefixes within the range have been verified; it's possible that the printer skipped some letters/numbers for unknown reasons. Also, there may be cross-overs (i.e. the same series/prefix appears on different types or varieties), therefore the series/prefixes shouldn't be used as the sole determining factor in identifying a note.

Qatar & Dubai Currency Board

From 1959 until 1966, Qatar used the Indian rupee as currency, in the form of Gulf rupees. When India devalued the rupee, Qatar adopted the Saudi riyal from 11 June 1966, until 18 September 1966, at which time the Qatar-Dubai Currency Board (QDCB) introduced the Qatar-Dubai riyal. The Saudi riyal was worth 1.065 rupees, while the Qatar-Dubai riyal was equal to the rupee prior to its devaluation.

On 17 October 2012, the Coin and Medal Department of Bonhams Auctioneers, London auctioned a complete set of

notes with matching serial number $1/1 \dots q$ in a blue leather presentation album inscribed *Council For the Currency of Qatar* \mathcal{O} *Dubai*. The set sold for £180,000 (US\$279,000) including buyer's premium.

Looking Forward

Following Dubai's entrance into the United Arab Emirates, Qatar began issuing the Qatari riyal separate from Dubai on 19 May 1973. The old notes continued to circulate in parallel for 90 days, at which time they were withdrawn.


